

Neighborhood Watch Information

Neighborhood Watch is an effective crime prevention effort that enlists the active participation of residents in cooperation with law enforcement to reduce crime. Lost Creek is a safe community. Let's keep it that way!

The goal of Neighborhood Watch is to keep our neighborhood safe. To do this, it is important for the Lost Creek residents to be the Eyes and Ears of the neighborhood and to work together as a community, sharing information.

The Block Captain is an integral component to keeping the group of neighbors assigned actively involved in crime prevention efforts, as well as the important process of information exchange between neighbors. Many thanks to all of our Block Captains for taking on this role!

You can view the list of 15 Block Captains with the neighbors assigned to each on the Lost Creek website. Please notify your Block Captain if you need information about the group assigned to him/her.

Neighborhood Watch is for CRIME PREVENTION! It is NOT for issues, such as problems with a neighbor, concerns about trash cans being out, or lawns needing mowing. ACC issues are NOT Neighborhood Watch concerns! Do not bring ACC concerns to your Block Captain!

If you observe any criminal activity, CALL 911!! Then notify your Block Captain. If you notice something suspicious, like a car parked for a while with people in it, or someone going door to door, tell your Block Captain. If something needs immediate attention, CALL 911! It is important that the whole neighborhood be informed of any suspicious activity.

If you are aware of any activity that would be a concern to your neighbors, tell your Block Captain. Your Block Captain will post this information BOTH on our Lost Creek group email and on the NextDoor site (the NextDoor site includes many surrounding neighborhoods, so you can be aware of vandalism, break-ins, etc. happening in the general community).

The Neighborhood Watch sign is posted near the entrance to Lost Creek.
